Any words that are unreadable or misspelled are not counted.</li> </ul>		
July	24	NOUN GENDER	<ul> <li>Write 3 statements about yourself on the board, two of which should be lies and one which should be true.</li> <li>Allow your students to ask you questions about each statement and then guess which one is the truth. You might want to practice your poker face before starting this game!</li> <li>If they guess correctly then they win.</li> <li>Extension: Give students time to write their own two truths and one lie.</li> <li>Pair them up and have them play again, this time with their list, with their new partner. If you want to really extend the game and give students even more time</li> </ul>		

			to practice their speaking/listening skills,
			<ul> <li>rotate partners every five minutes.</li> <li>Bring the whole class back together and have students announce one new thing they learned about another student as a recap.</li> </ul>
August	25	PRONOUN KIND OF ADJECTIVES DEGREE OF COMPARISON	<ul> <li>Stand in front of the class (you are Simon for the duration of this game).</li> <li>Do an action and say Simon Says [action]. The students must copy what you do.</li> <li>Repeat this process choosing different actions - you can be as silly as you like and the sillier you are the more the children will love you for it.</li> <li>Then do an action but this time say only the action and omit 'Simon Says'. Whoever does the action this time is out and must sit down.</li> <li>The winner is the last student standing.</li> <li>To make it harder, speed up the actions. Reward children for good behavior by allowing them to play the part of Simon.</li> </ul>
